

After completion of action against one he may be deal with another traffic violator.
3	Can a member of the public file a complaint if they see 3 or perhaps 4 people commute on a motorcycle? Kindly provide documented copies of guidelines/rules the explain the process for filling such a complaint.	Kindly refer see 155 of Cr.P.C. 1973. It is self explanatory.
