Subject: Information sought under RTI Act 2005.

Sir,

With reference to your RTI application dated 31.01.2022, it is informed that your RTI information sought does not pertain to the Lokpal of India. It appears that NCRB is not furnishing some information to you. You may take up the issue with appellate authority in NCRB or CIC (Central Information Commissioner) who have mandate to look into these issues as per provisions of RTI Act, 2005. Lokpal is not the appropriate forum to raise such issues with.

2. Further, you have said that if the information does not pertain to us we should transfer the RTI application to the appropriate PIO. In this regard, it is informed that the particulars of CFPB (NCRB) is not known to us. Further, state government departments can transfer the RTI application to the other departments of state government and Central Government departments to other Central Government departments if the information partially pertains to them and partially to other departments. Lokpal of India is neither a state government department nor a central government department. You may approach directly to the concerned RTI authorities as per provisions.

3. Hence, your original RTI application along with IPO No. 236479 worth Rs 10 is returned herewith.
