The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights, (NCPCR), a statutory body established under the Commissions for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005, is mandated for monitoring the implementation of provisions of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

2. The Commission has taken a *suo motu* cognizance of an incident published in the Times of India on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2017 'Hyderabad worries as drug racket networks students'. As per the above newspaper, Director (Enforcement), Hyderabad stated that the peddlers used WhatsApp to route drugs. The students of top 25 premier schools and 20 top colleges were customers of this gang that was selling LS (lysergic acid, diethylamide), commonly called acid and MDMA (methylene-dioxymethamphetamine). The students are being misused by drug rackets. The situation is very alarming.

3. The Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 contains provisions under Section 78 prohibits issuing a child for vending, peddling, carrying, supplying or smuggling any intoxicating liquor, narcotic drug or psychotropic substance while section 77 states the severe punishment attached for misuse of children for these purposes.

In view of above, it is requested that necessary directions may please be issued to all concerned to ensure effective implementation of the above provisions of the Juvenile Justice Act for checking this menace before it is too late. It is also requested that this Commission may please be apprised about the action taken in the matter by your Department.
