ORDER :-

The Government have issued orders declaring the posts of Inspector of Fisheries in Andhra Pradesh Fisheries Subordinate Service in the scale of pay of Rs.2600-5580 as first level Gazetted post in Fisheries Department and redesignated as Fisheries Development Officer in G.O.3rd read above. Consequently necessary amendment to Andhra Pradesh Fisheries Service Rules has to be issued.

2. Government after careful examination issue necessary amendment to Andhra Pradesh Fisheries Service Rules issued in the G.O. second read above.
3. The following notification will be published in the next issue of Rules Supplement of Andhra Pradesh Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby make the following Amendments to the Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Fisheries Service issued in G.O.Ms.No.316, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries (Fish.I) Department, dt:9.4.1991:-

AMENDMENTS

- a) In Class.I of Rule 2 after category.4., the following shall be substituted as Category.5. "Category.5. - Fisheries Development Officer".
- b) The existing Category 5 shall be renumbered as Category 6. "Category 6:- P.A. to Director of Fisheries"
- c) In Class-I Rule-3, for the existing Category.4, the following shall be substituted.
(4) Assistant Director of Fisheries (i) By Director recruitment;
(ii) By Promotion from the category of Fisheries Development Officer in A.P.F.S. and by transfer from the categories of Research Assistant and Hydrologist in the A.P.F.S.Ss.
- d) In Class-I of Rule.3, after Category 4, the following shall be substituted as Category 5.

- "(5) Fisheries Development Officer (i) BY director recruitment-
- (ii) By recruitment by promotion from category-2 of Class I of A.P.F.S.S.Rules.
 - (iii) By recruitment by Transfer of Senior Assistant in the Fisheries Department.
 - (iv) By recruitment by transfer of Assistant Section Officers of Andhra Pradesh Secretariat.

NOTE-1. In a unit of 5 vacancies in the posts of Fisheries Development Officers, the Appointments by the different methods of appointment shall be as follows:-

- 1st vacancy - By direct recruitment.
- 2nd vacancy - By recruitment by promotion.
- 3rd vacancy - By recruitment by transfer from Senior Assistants of Directorate of Fisheries, Senior Assistants of Subordinate Offices of Fisheries Department in the relevant unit of appointment and Assistant Section Officers of Secretariat.
- 4th vacancy - By direct recruitment.
- 5th vacancy - By recruitment by promotion.

The 3rd vacancy in 3 successive cycles shall be filled in the first cycle by the Senior Assistants of Directorate of Fisheries, in the second cycle by the Senior Assistants of the Subordinate Offices of the Fisheries Department in the relevant unit of appointment and in the 3rd cycle by the Assistant Section Officers of the Andhra Pradesh Secretariat.

NOTE -2. If no qualified person is available either by appointment by transfer or by promotion, the tenure of such category shall lapse.

- e) "The existing Category 5 shall be renumbered as Category 6".
- f) "The existing Rule 11 shall be substituted as follows:-

Provided that :

- (i) Candidates who hold a degree in Oceanography shall not be required to pass the Departmental Test II (in six (6) papers). Each part of the test will be treated as a separate unit and a person who is required to pass more than one paper shall be allowed to pass them one after another, after completion of their training.
- (ii) Candidates who, have successfully completed the full course of Inland of Marine Fisheries Classes conducted by the Government of India or who possess a diploma in the Fisheries Technology and Navigation of a recognized polytechnic in the State of Andhra Pradesh shall not be required to pass the Departmental Test: I.
- (iii) Candidates who possess post Graduate Diploma in Fisheries Technology and Navigation awarded by the Technological Diploma Board shall not be required to pass the Departmental Test. II.

(iv) Candidates who have already passed the Test in Part. II B Inland Fish culture under the old system, shall not be required to pass the test in Inland Fisheries under the new system

Note (i) If the candidates fail to complete the practical training satisfactorily, the period of training may be extended by three weeks in each subject, but he/she shall not be eligible for any pay and allowances for the period of such extension, if he/she is a direct recruit. If he/she fails to complete the training satisfactorily even within the period of such extension, his/her name shall be removed from the approved list or his/her probation shall be terminated forthwith.

RULE-11 (A) : Unit of appointment and appointing authority:

For purposes of recruitment, appointment by transfer, discharge for want of vacancy, seniority, promotion, transfer and appointment as full member the unit of appointment and the appointing authority for the posts of Fisheries Development Officer shall be as follows:-
